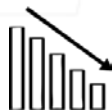

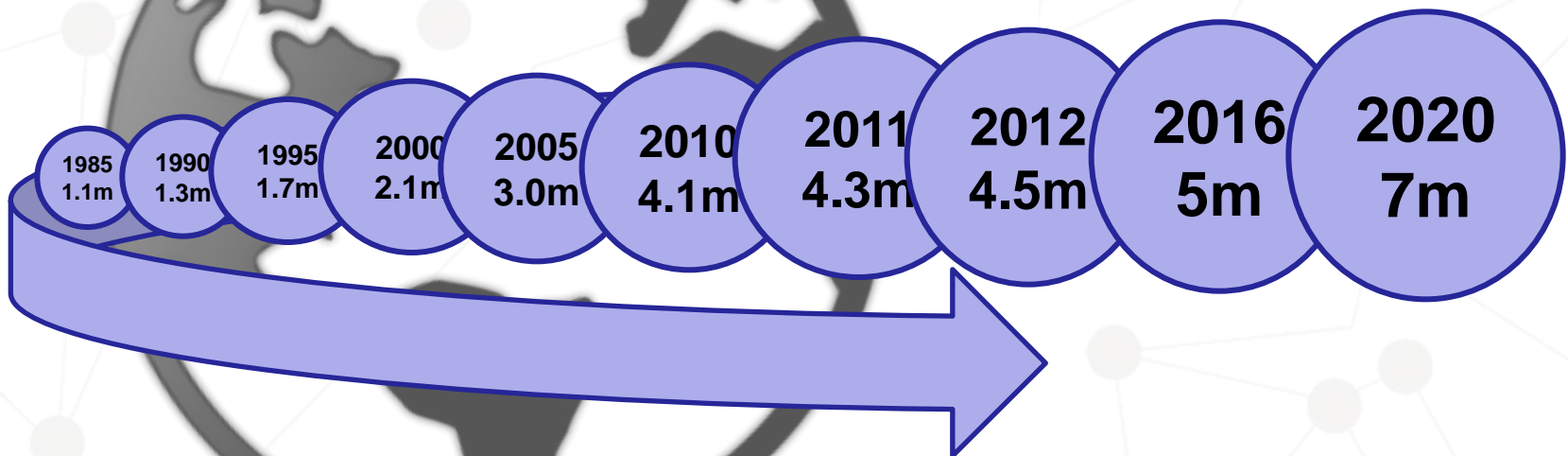

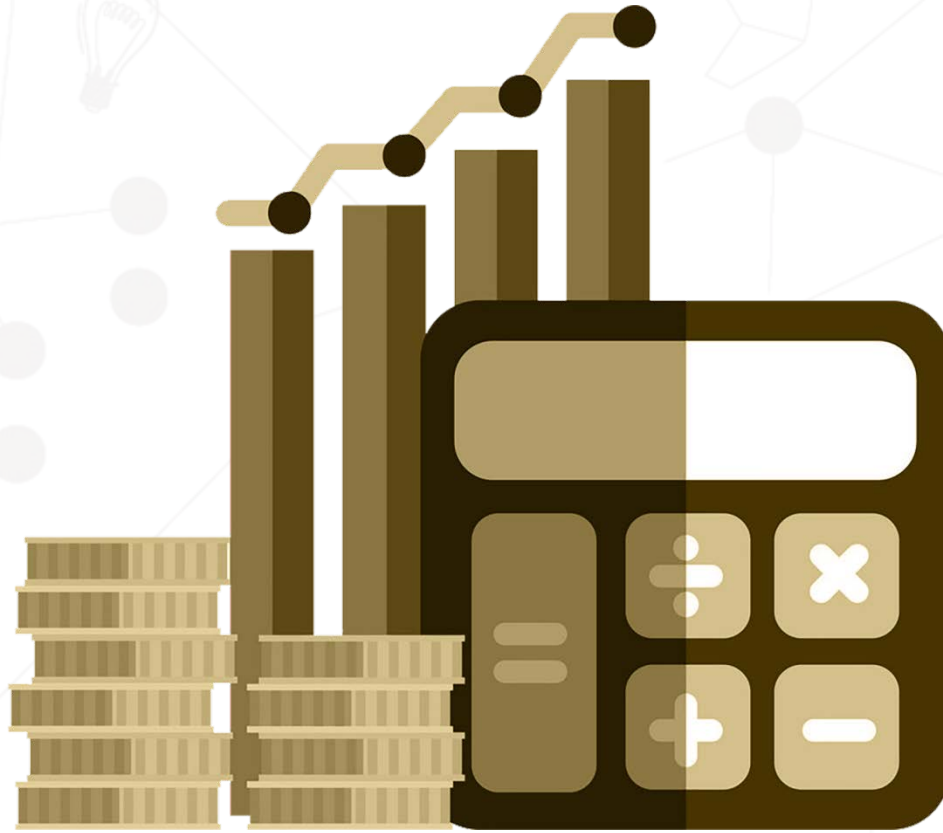

GROWING EDUCATIONAL OFFER



In the case of Russia, in recent years we are witnessing a continuous increase in the number of Russian students choosing Spain as an educational destination.



According to the statistics extracted from the Integrated University Information System (SIU-MCIU), the evolution in the number of Russian students has been very positive, increasing by 16% since the 2015/2016 academic year.

Moreover, as the level of mobility between Spain and Russia is not very high, it is important to maintain contacts with those responsible for higher education institutions.

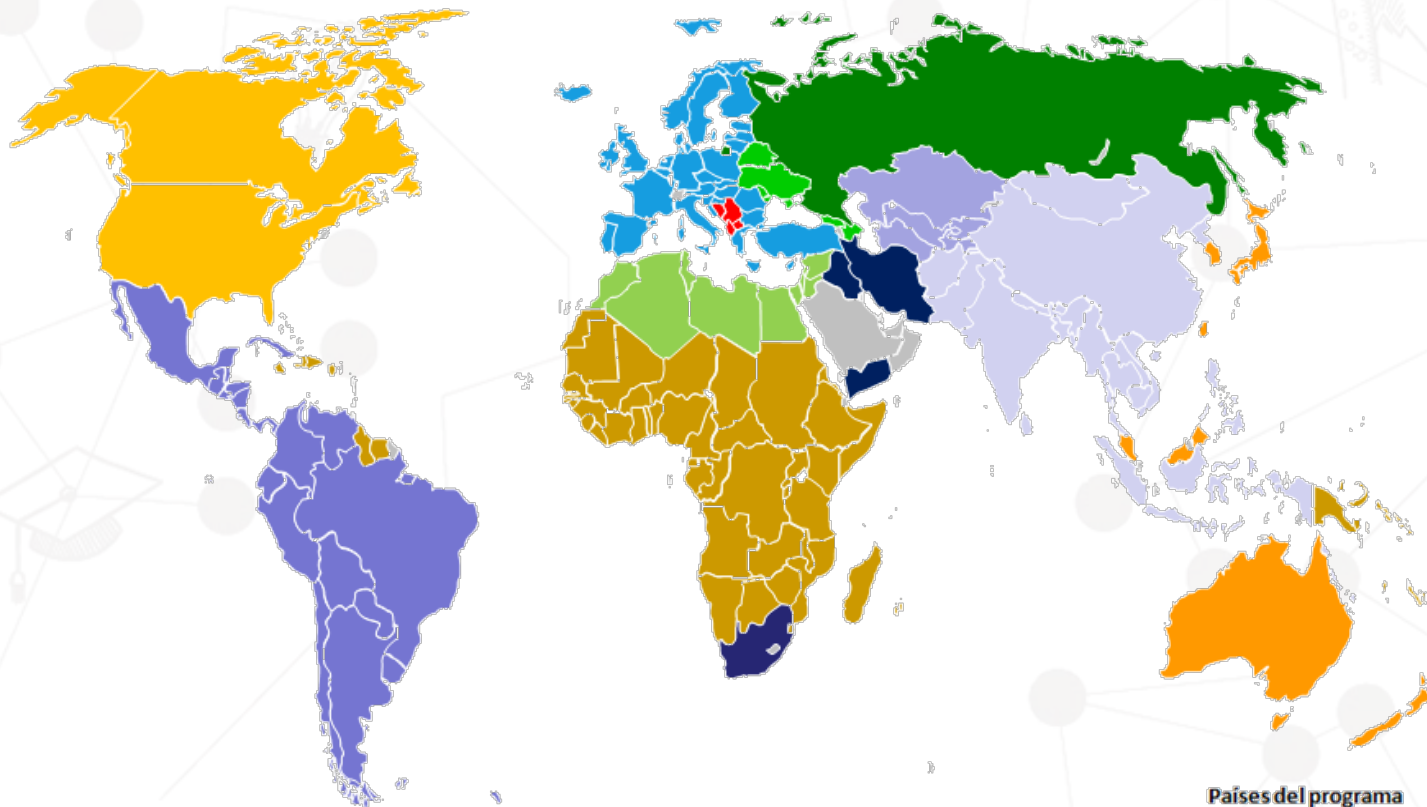
