All the participants who want to propose a presentation or poster are requested to submit a **one-page** abstract to the workshop Secretariat no later than **15th February, 2016**. Authors will be notified as soon as possible as to whether their abstracts have been accepted. Abstracts should briefly outline the main features, results and conclusions as well as their general significance, and should contain relevant references. The extension of this abstract is just one page.

Please follow the instructions for preparation of abstracts carefully, in order to ensure standardized formats. The abstract must contain the full name, full address and e-mail of author. In the case of joint authorship, the name of the author who will actually present the paper at the workshop should be underlined. If no e-mail address is underlined, the notification of acceptance will be sent to the underlined author, otherwise to the underlined e-mail address. Only presentations by the author are permitted.

In the case that there exist figures or tables, these should be embedded at the appropriate point within the text. They may span both

columns if necessary. When referring to a figure, use cross-reference in text (e.g. Figure ?? provides an example of this point).

Figures should be supplied separately. Use these file formats only: eps (preferred format), ps, pdf, jpeg (.jpg).

Electronic submission is required to be sent to the Conference address **nolineal16@us.es** under the email subject **ABSTRACT-CONTRIBUTION**.

Please, name your files after the lastname of the first author, that is **lastname.tex**, and send both the .tex and .pdf files. In the case that you insert a figure in the abstract, you should send the .eps file.
